If you wish to apply to ASPA for sponsorship please complete the form below, have it signed by your patrol captain/director and return it by **30 July 2008**.

Assessment Criteria for attendance assistance funding will take into account:

- You being a suitable representative of ASPA so as to fill the roll of an ASPA Delegate at the Congress
- You making a presentation at FIPS (if you are making a presentation details must be provided)
- Previous ASPA support for attendance at FIPS meetings. Preference will be given to patrollers who have not previously received ASPA travel assistance
- Your role in your Patrol eg training officer, Patrol Captain, etc
- The benefit to your Patrol by your attendance at FIPS
- The benefit to ASPA and Australian ski patrollers by your attendance at FIPS
- The benefit to FIPS by your attendance

The following conditions apply, that upon your return:

- You prepare a detailed report for ASPA on the congress that would be of benefit/interest to Australian ski patrollers. At the request of the Leader of the ASPA Delegation you may be asked to gather information and report on a particular aspect of the Congress. The report must be completed by June 2009 in time for the pre winter issue of "Asparations" as your report may be included.
- You make a presentation to your Patrol. Details and timing must be provided to ASPA
- You make presentations on your FIPS visit at meetings arranged by ASPA in at least two states. ASPA will endeavour to assist you with travel expenses for these presentations

Your application must have the written/email approval of your Patrol Captain. Late application will only be accepted at the discretion of the ASPA Executive.

Presentations at FIPS

Please be aware each country being represented at the congress is given a certain time allocation to present either indoor or outdoor presentations. Typically this means ASPA would have the opportunity to deliver up to four presentations of around 50min. each. You may be asked to make a joint presentation or to assist another delegate with their presentation.

The report must be prepared using MS Word and include:

- Report Summary
- For each item in the report:
 - Item Title
 - Item demonstration/presentation by
 - Relevant background information
 - Details of the specific item
 - Appropriate photos
 - If appropriate, an assessment of benefits and limitations
 - Any conclusions and recommendations for further consideration by Australian ski patrols
 - Details/copies of any support documentation, electronic information, contact details, etc

A final draft of your report must be provided to the ASPA VP international Liaison for feedback on format and to ensure coordination with other reports.
